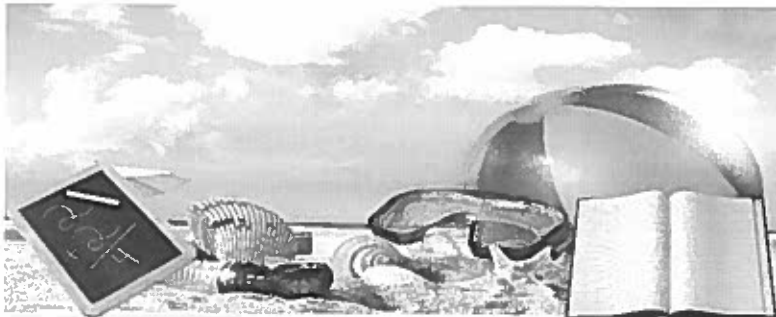


Dear Parents,



I am so excited to have your child this upcoming year! We are going to have such a great year. Your child has worked very hard this past school year. We want them to be able to practice what they have learned in order to retain the information. First grade is a time where the understanding of basic math and reading is essential. It is important to practice reading and math over the summer so that your student is confident when starting the new school year.

Benefits of summer reading:

Individualized reading material

Summer Reading Requirement:

I ask that your child read 15 minutes or more everyday. There is a Summer Reading BINGO page that you can print out and color in each square once completed. After you complete the square, write down what book you read and how long you read for in the reading log. Students should use Raz kids at least twice a week. The username and password should be the same as the one used in Kindergarten.

Resources/Suggestions:

- Raz Kids – students are able to log on to listen or read stories that are on their level. After the story, they complete a comprehension quiz. For every book they read and quiz they complete, they earn stars to be used to create their rocket ship. When reading on here, have your child read the book, listen to the book, then take the quiz.
- Have your child get a library card.
- Starfall- free when using on a computer.
- ABCya.com

Summer Math Requirement:

Review math fluency facts on Moby Max. Dedicate up to 20 minutes a week for this. There is no math log for this.

Resources/Suggestions:

- Moby Max- students are able to log in and work on math lessons based on what they need to work on. There is also a section called “Fact Fluency”. This is a great way to help with addition and subtraction facts.
 - The username and password is the same as kindergarten.
